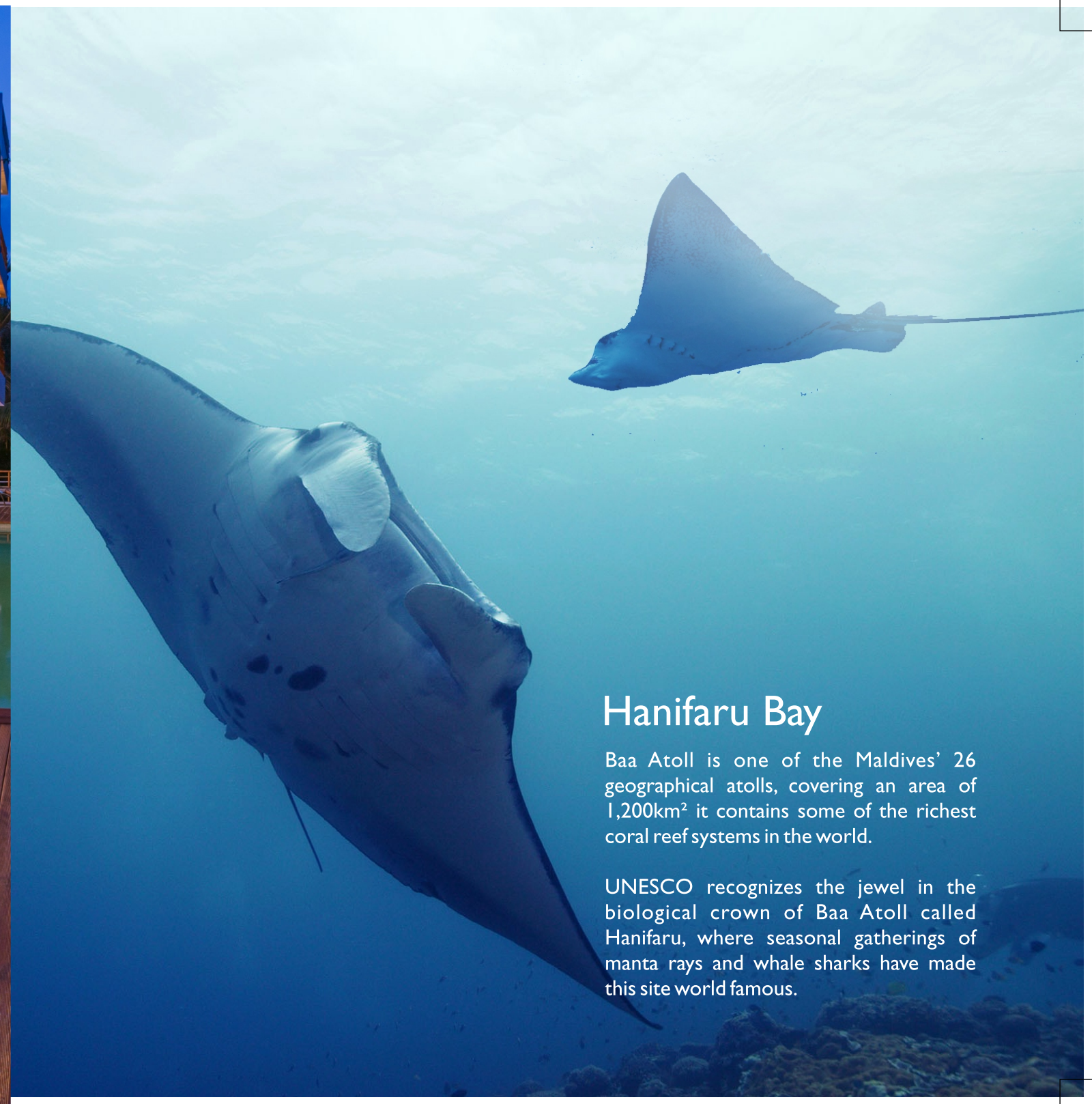

Hanifaru Bay

Baa Atoll is one of the Maldives' 26 geographical atolls, covering an area of 1,200km² it contains some of the richest coral reef systems in the world.

UNESCO recognizes the jewel in the biological crown of Baa Atoll called Hanifaru, where seasonal gatherings of manta rays and whale sharks have made this site world famous.

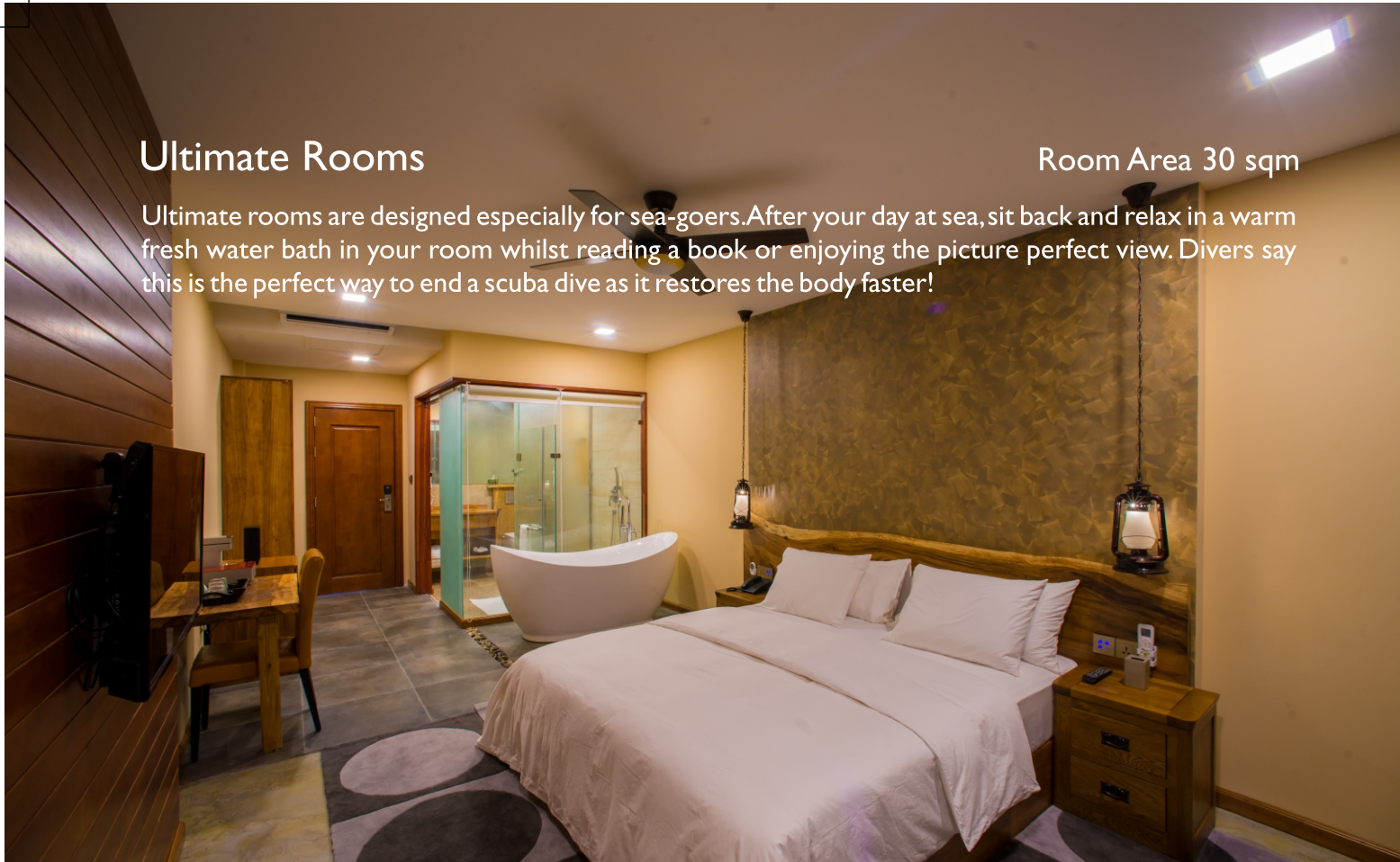

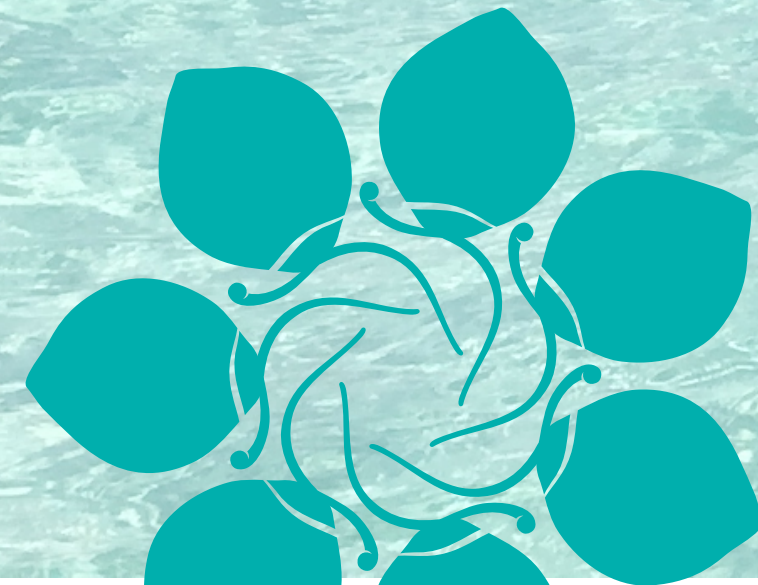
Sand Banks & Excursions

Maalhos Island

This neighbouring island with a small population is well-known for a local nut also referred to as sea almonds. This nut is a Maldivian ingredient used in traditional delicacies. On designated days, all islanders ceremoniously collect the fallen nuts from the entire island. Amicably they follow the custom of keeping one's own find for themselves and no picking of this nut on any other day. This old tradition promotes conservation of this plant and preservation of traditional cuisine.

Sand Banks

Part of 'island life' is taking a trip to a sand bank and having complete disconnection with the world. To be alone with your chosen company and roosting sea birds is a unique experience. White terns and frigate birds are frequent visitors to our nearby sandbanks. To complete your hassle free experience we will organise your picnic.





Snorkelling

If you are not a fan of scuba diving, not to worry. Baa atoll is one place where you don't need gear to witness one of the most spectacular shows marine life has to offer.

Our waters are world renowned for high visibility and warmth. This makes snorkelling a relaxing experience. And some say it is even therapeutic!

Kihaadhoo reef

This nearby island with a small population offers a different experience. Within our waters there are 1200 reef associated fish species therefore you are bound to meet a fish that you will fall in love with.

Hanifaru Bay

This neighbouring reef is a core-protected zone under the UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. This region is rich in fauna with a unique water circulation system. Seasonally exceptionally large numbers of manta rays gather for a feeding frenzy. During the same period, gentle whale sharks breed here. This is also a nesting site for green and hawksbill turtles. This magical gathering is world famous and we are here to help you be part of it.

Afternoon Tea

Light additions such as breadfruit crisps and yam crisps are unique ingredients to Maldives.

Culturally this is a family and social time of the day. On special occasions, afternoon tea receptions are held for family, friends and neighbours. This custom is followed at official ceremonies by the state too.
