Cássio Vasconcelos, Brazil

This series of photographs is inspired by the engravings and landscape paintings of the traveling artists of the early 19th century. Created two centuries later and translated through the lens of photography, it is as if the artist as tried to go back in time to experience the sensation of discovering these sublime pieces.
- 2** SKYSPACE AMARTA
James Turrell, USA

The specifically proportioned chamber with an aperture in the ceiling open to the sky is a manifestation of Turrell's lifelong devotion towards exploring space and the light that inhabits it. It invites guests to contemplate their own perception of form as they immerse themselves in the sensual abundance of light, colour and openness in Turrell's sky-scape.
- 3** SYNTHESIS MONOLITHS

Synthesis Monolith plays with the notion of the uncanny; initial familiarity is undermined by uncertainties around the properties of materials, the objects' origins, and the processes through which they were made.
- 4** HOME DEEP BLUE

The artist approached the composition of this work three dimensionally – laterally, vertically and topographically. Horizontal movement and distance merge with the nearness and depth of the ocean up through the surface to the sky.
- 5** OCEAN ARCHAEOLOGY OF OUR TIME

Presenting a formidable testament to environmental stewardship at Patina Maldives—a masterpiece by renowned conceptual artist and environmental activist, Pamela Longobardi. This captivating installation, crafted from 21.73 kilograms of repurposed marine plastic, not only highlights Longobardi's creativity but also stands as a compelling reminder of our collective responsibility to safeguard our oceans.
- 6** MOMENTO

(In Between Villa 110 and 111)

This work of art is a construction of temporal moment that hovers over the beach, building a new space of dialogue between the human body with the landscape and time that surrounds it.
- 7** LOS LÍMITES DE LO POSIBLE IX
Jose Dávila, Mexico

The Beach House

This intervention comprises a series of sculptures executed with volumes made with recinto, a kind of volcanic rock, and raw sandstone boulders. The interaction between perfect geometric shapes of the recinto volumes and the capricious forms of the unaltered boulders, reveals a relation of contrast which is essential part of Dávila's sculptural practice.
- 8** LIFE
Sassan Behnam-Bakhtiar

Representing the language of energy and nature, and referencing a prosperous way of life, this artwork was created using predominantly natural pigments sourced from minerals, wood, roots, flowers, rocks, soil, recycled pigments, and ground washed out shells and corals gathered from around the island. Ensuring the wood and linen used for the canvas are sustainably sourced and naturally treated, the artist pioneers a harmony between traditional art practices and nature, setting a precedent in the contemporary art world.
