OUR CONSERVATION PROMISE

Conservation through education helps us improve peoples' knowledge, behaviour, emotions and attitude towards conserving unique island life and the environment. This can be done through various techniques that aid in reconnecting people with the natural world. In Reethi Faru Resort, we've adopted different methods to help people understand the ecological importance and conservation of the marine and terrestrial world.



Solar energy

Installed capacity: 1004 kWh

To operate on sustainable energy, the resort installed 3602 solar panels on the roofs in the back of the house. The solar panels were installed upon phases, and as of right now, the resort has a capacity of 1004 kWh, which is currently the highest in the Maldives. The electrical energy generated is connected to the grid, and 40% of the resort load is run on solar energy during the day without the requirement of diesel consumption.

RO plant

Installed capacity: 3 plants of 150 cubic meters/day and 1 plant of 300 cubic meters/day for domestic usage (bathing/cleaning/laundry) and 1 unit of 50 cubic meters/day for drinking water. The intake of plants is seawater that is desalinated and converted into freshwater. We also have an energy recovery system that is inbuilt in the plants to reduce energy consumption. Reethi fen - our still and sparkling bottled water is 100% produced in-house with strict quality control through these plants.

Wastewater

Organically treated - all sewage water is treated on the island in our state-of-the-art sewage treatment plant. This is then used for gardening purposes and irrigation, with the rest getting recycled back into the ocean. The technology and process used have helped us reduce at least 180 kilolitres/day, which would have been necessary otherwise.

Heat exchangers

Hot water supply on the island is generated through heat exchangers, tagged with the generators, which produce enough heat to generate hot water. Heaters and boilers are not used on the island, thereby reducing the carbon footprint making it one of the most energy-efficient islands in the Maldives.

Biogas plant

Food waste and horticulture waste are segregated from other waste and used to produce biogas used for staff area kitchen for cooking purposes. All 100% waste that is generated is being recycled, and the biogas supplies all three meals that are served for over 350 staff members.

LED lights

99% of lights around the island are LED as part of the resort's conservation plan.

Tree relocation

Our team avoided cutting down trees during construction, and whichever were in the construction area was safely relocated. In addition, mobilization of machinery which would harm corals in our lagoon were avoided, and where required, they were relocated.

Buildings

A combination of soil stabilized earthen blocks and aerated cement blocks were used in creating our buildings. These materials are eco-friendly, function as natural heat insulators and help keep the carbon footprint as low as possible.

Air conditioning

All air-conditioners on the island are non-CFC. Likewise, the refrigerant gas (cooling gas) is eco-friendly with a non-CFC component.

Waste management

Plastic, glass, metal, paper, cardboard, and wood are all separated on the island and shipped away for possible recycling.

Plastic management

RFR collaborates with Parley for the Oceans to manage the plastic waste on the island and to avoid and intercept their entry into the marine ecosystems.





MARINE CONSERVATION AT REETHI FARU RESORT

At Reethi Faru, we know the importance of conserving the natural environment and strive to do so every day. From construction - marine environment taken into consideration; when beams were being set up for the water villas and jetties, coral was relocated around the house reef and not destroyed or damaged. The turquoise blue waters of the Maldives are one of the main attractions of the nation, which brings in millions of people from all over the world. Therefore, it is imperative to protect and preserve the marine ecosystems and all their inhabitants so that future generations can appreciate the same benefits that we enjoy today. Reethi Faru Management is deeply committed to this cause.

Artificial reefs

Set up during the construction phase to help boost the growth of coral reefs around the island. More nurseries are being set up around the island in the shallow and deep end of the house reef. After 2016 El Nino, most coral reefs were affected in and around the Maldives. Artificial reefs are a way to restore the reefs, one of our main initiatives in the resort. So far, we have seen a lot of corals' recovery and regeneration around the house reef and artificial reef. Conservation of coral reefs is imperative to show the presence and survival of other marine life; sharks are a sign of a healthy reef. At Reethi Faru resort, we have various species of friendly sharks present, which has a positive impact on other fish in the reef.

House reef

The most common sightings will be curious turtles, eagle rays, sharks, dolphins and schools of fish all around.

Marine life

Marine conservation efforts for certain megafauna species are also being made by collaborating with Manta Trust and Olive Ridley Project for manta rays and turtles, respectively.

Reethi Day

At Reethi Faru, we are mindful of protecting our environment, both marine and terrestrial. That is how our monthly "Reethi Day" (Translates to Beautiful Day) initiative began, a day to celebrate the environment and help conserve it through education and activities with the whole team. Even guests participate in coral planting, reef clean-ups, beach clean-ups, tree planting, educational presentations, guided awareness snorkels and more on the monthly Reethi Day!
