

Kids Club (Kulh-un) guidelines:

NOOE Maldives Kunaavashi Resort & Spa Kids' Club (Kulh-un) is for the convenience of the resort guests while staying at the resort. Our well-designed, modern facility is available for children the following ages: 0-12 Years

- Children under 4 years are only allowed to the Kids Club if accompanied by an adult
- or request for babysitting with extra cost and subject availability.
- Private babysitting is available on request and is on chargeable basis \$20 per hour, subject to 10% Service Charge & 16% Tourism Goods and Services Tax).
- If the babysitting service is during the lunch (12pm to 2pm) or dinner (6pm to 8pm) period, guest should provide courtesy meal for baby sitter.
- Children 4 years old and above are welcome to use the kids club facilities during opening hours of the Kids Club.

Kids Club Opening Hours

- OPEN – 09:00AM TO 12:30PM
- Break – 12:30PM TO 01:30PM
- OPEN – 01:30PM TO 6:00PM

Kids club Terms & conditions:

- Parents, guardians, or families with a babysitter will be able to stay in the Kids Club all the necessary time that their child will need to feel comfortable with our Kids Club team members.
- For the safety of all children, glass bottles, cups, outside food and snacks are not permitted in the Kids' Club.
- Children must have clean diapers upon entering the Kids' Club.
- All children's belongings should be labeled.
- No toys from outside are to be brought into the Kids' Club.
- For the safety of your child and to comply with the Kids Club policies and regulations, the children must be collected by their parents/guardian.
- Once a child is checked into the Kids' Club, he/she will not be permitted to leave unless properly checked out by their parent.
- If a child is upset or uncomfortable for a period of ten (10) minutes or longer, the Staff has the option to request parental assistant.
- If a child is ill, please DO NOT bring him/her to the Kids' Club. If your child has an allergy, please bring a note from resort General Practice.
- Symptoms with those of a cold or flu. Staff has authorization and obligation to deny use of the Kids' Club to sick children.
- Well-behaved children are always welcomed in our Kids' Club. Incidents that require discipline and compromise the safety of other children, the staff will ask for parental assistant.
